Rep. John McCravy (SC) Praised for Courageous Leadership and Commitment to Biblical Values

Phoenix, AZ – Jason Rapert, Founder and President of the National Association of Christian Lawmakers (NACL), has issued a statement praising South Carolina State Representative John McCravy (R-Greenwood) for his unwavering commitment to Biblical principles. Rep. McCravy is a charter member of the NACL and serves as the South Carolina State Chair.

Recently, Rep. McCravy made the difficult decision to resign from his position as a ranking member of the South Carolina House Judiciary Committee. He is the founder of the South Carolina Legislative Family Caucus. He has also championed legislation important to his state and the country including the Heartbeat Bill, Help not Harm, Save Women's Sports legislation, fought for the Human Life Protection Act, and opposed the spread of alcohol deregulation, sports betting, and transgender-affirming hate crimes legislation. His actions have consistently demonstrated his dedication to defending godly principles, even when it requires personal sacrifice.

“Rep. John McCravy is a godly example of exactly the kind of legislator America desperately needs,” said Jason Rapert. “He has chosen to take the hard path of standing against evil and upholding Biblical truth, even at the cost of power and influence. His courage to step away from a coveted position on the Judiciary Committee rather than compromise his values is a testament to his faith and integrity. It is also a loss for the good people of South Carolina.”

Despite the inevitable backlash and criticism Rep. McCravy likely will face for standing firm for what is right, his resolve to uphold Biblical values serves as a powerful reminder that true leadership often comes with great personal and political cost.

“As the incoming National Chair of the NACL National Legislative Council, Rep. McCravy’s leadership will undoubtedly inspire legislators across the nation to follow his example of principled governance. I personally believe the Speaker of the South Carolina House of Representatives should take action and stop the petty retaliation against Rep. John McCravy. Faith based leaders around South Carolina and the entire nation are monitoring this situation and are praying members of the South Carolina House will take a stand for what is right,” Rapert said.
