RE: Apology Demanded for Anti-Christian Bigotry During 2024 Olympic Ceremonies

Dear Mr. Bach & International Olympic Committee Members,

It is with deep disappointment that I reach out to you on behalf of the members and supporters of the National Association of Christian Lawmakers to demand a public apology for the recent anti-Christian bigotry that you highlighted and displayed during the opening ceremonies of the Olympic Games in France.

Christian leaders and millions of Christians around the world have declared their outrage and disgust at the live performance orchestrated by you and the Olympic Committee which mocked Jesus Christ and the Last Supper. It was an intentional act using drag queens meant to mock and demean the values of Christians everywhere. The inclusion of a minor child in this sexually lewd and perverted display is also extremely offensive and demeaning to children who are preyed upon by sex traffickers around the globe.
