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## **NACL-Led Coalition Sends Letter to President Trump Urging Protection for Jewish Canadians Facing Antisemitic Persecution**

**CONWAY, Ark.** —The National Association of Christian Lawmakers (NACL) announced today that a coalition of **54 Christian, Jewish, governmental, legal, civic, and ministry leaders** has signed and sent a letter to President Donald J. Trump urging his Administration to consider establishing a lawful, secure, and appropriately expedited immigration and humanitarian pathway for Jewish Canadians facing antisemitic persecution.

The letter, signed by NACL Founder and President Jason Rapert and 53 additional co-signers, includes 31 sitting state legislators representing 24 states, former U.S. Ambassador-at-Large for International Religious Freedom Sam Brownback, and leaders from the religious-liberty, pro-Israel, ministry, legal, civic, and media communities.

“America has a long and honorable tradition of providing refuge to those fleeing religious persecution,” the letter states. “Religious liberty must be more than a principle we proclaim; it must be a principle we are willing to defend.”

The signatories are asking the Trump Administration to identify lawful pathways for eligible Jewish Canadian individuals and families who face persecution or credibly fear persecution because of their Jewish identity or faith, while maintaining appropriate national security, identity, medical, admissibility, and security screening requirements.

The letter also emphasizes the willingness of Christian and Jewish communities, faith-based organizations, states, local governments, employers, and private citizens to assist eligible families who choose to build new lives in the United States.

“Antisemitism is a moral evil, and Christians must be willing to stand with our Jewish friends when they face hatred and persecution,” said Rapert. “We are asking President Trump and his Administration to consider what lawful steps America can take to help Jewish Canadian families who are genuinely concerned for their safety.”
