3. Submit a two-page biographical sketch of the nominee's early life, including parents, siblings, and schools attended."
4. Submit a nomination letter detailing the following.

Evidence nominees have demonstrated themselves as a role model to students, colleagues, parents, and community leaders.

- a. Evidence nominee has demonstrated a passion for education and student success.
 - b. Evidence nominee has demonstrated the pursuit of knowledge through the obtaining of additional hours, certificates, or degrees.
 - c. Evidence of professional and community involvement.
 - d. Evidence of awards or special recognition.
5. Submit two supporting letters of recommendation from a colleague, friend, family member, or student.
6. Submit one professional 8x10 black and white photo of the nominee (photo will not be returned).
7. In addition, if selected, an inductee or representative will be required to complete a 45-minute video interview during the month of June 2026 tentatively set at the Oklahoma History Center.
