

2020 ANNUAL FUNRAISER: THE JUDY BLACK MEMORIAL PARK AND GARDENS COVID PROTOCOLS

For the safety of our guests, performers, staff, and volunteers, the following protocols are in place for this event:

Parking on the Day of the Event

- Guests may park in designated spaces around Bryan Memorial Plaza. Please refrain from parking in front of the Washington Market as their doors are open until 6 PM.
- Please bring personal protection gear, including masks, before leaving the parking area.
- Guests who pre-registered for Premium Reserved seats may pick up their picnic and champagne at The Judy Black Memorial Park and Gardens before walking to the entry gate.

Entrance

- The entry gate will open at 4:30 PM. All guests entering through this gate are required to wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth. Admittance without a mask will be prohibited.
- A no-touch process will be utilized for check-in.
- Masks must be worn as guests move about the event. Once guests are seated, masks can be removed.
- Guests should maintain 6' social distance between themselves and other groups, staff, and volunteers, at all times.

Seating for Premium Reserved and Reserved Guests

- Seating is by section. Each section measures 8' X 8' with seating for a maximum of 6 adults. Sections will be spaced 15' apart allowing groups to move about while maintaining 6' distance between them.
- Guests will be escorted to their seats by a volunteer. Once seated in their section, guests may remove their masks at their own discretion.

Seating for Individual Guests on the Side Lawn

- Guests will be escorted to a designated area by a volunteer. You are welcome to bring a chair or blanket.
- Lawn sections will be spaced 6' apart. Please refrain from moving between sections.
- Guests in the side lawn area are asked to keep their masks on until the show starts as guests and volunteers will be moving about this area. Once the show starts, seated guests can remove their masks.

Exiting the Event

- Guests are asked to exit by row as directed by the staff/volunteers at this event. For the safety of all, please refrain from social gatherings on the lawn of town hall.

Rest Rooms, Waste Cannisters

- Public restrooms will be accessible during this event. Masks must be worn when walking to and from the restroom. Please maintain 6' distance if there is a queue for the restroom. Restroom surfaces will be wiped down in between in each guest.
- No-touch waste canisters will be placed in visible locations around the lawn. Please place all personal refuse in the canister before leaving the lawn and maintain 6' distance if there is a queue.

Staff/Volunteer Protocols

- Training on safety protocols will take place prior to the event.
- All staff and volunteers will be screened for temperature and symptoms within two hours of the event start.
- Masks and gloves will be required at all times. Gloves will be replaced frequently.

General Information - Attendance to all events has been limited pursuant to state guidelines.

1. Advance reservations are required, please purchase your tickets by August 23, 2020.
