



THE JUDY BLACK
MEMORIAL PARK
AND GARDENS

APPLICATION TO EXHIBIT

The Judy Black Memorial Park and Gardens' mission is to create a gathering place in Washington that invites friends and neighbors to relax, learn, play and share all that our community offers. The space functions not only as an art gallery but as a space for public programs, performances, children's activities and qualified private events.

Application to Exhibit:

- Artist/Exhibitor shall submit via email or in person, examples of Art Work, an Artist/Exhibitor statement and a request to exhibit.
- Artist/Exhibitor shall be notified via email if their request has been approved by the Washington Park Foundation Inc. a/k/a The Judy Black Memorial Park and Gardens ("The Park") Exhibition Committee (EC). A formal invitation and an Artist/Exhibitor Agreement ("Agreement") will be included in the email. The signed Agreement, along with a usage fee of \$250, must be returned within 15 days of receipt of invitation.
- While submissions of art work of varying media (painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, etc.), is encouraged, the acceptance of specific art work for display and exhibition will depend on various factors, such as space limitations, overlapping exhibitions, and such decisions will be made on a case by case basis in consultation or collaboration with the artist/exhibitor.

General Guidelines:

- Invitations to display/exhibit are for a maximum 6-week period. The Artist/Exhibitor shall be responsible for the immediate removal of Art Work;
- The Artist/Exhibitor will provide The Park with a record of all works on exhibit;
- The Artist/Exhibitor shall retain artistic control over the exhibition and Art Work, and therefore is solely responsible for ALL exhibition-related expenses;
- The Artist/Exhibitor shall use the full name and logo of The Park on printed material used in conjunction with the exhibition;
- The Park will promote the exhibition via its website, other social media and local publications;
- Given that the Park and Gardens is both a public and volunteer driven space, we cannot guarantee on-site staff, all-day viewing hours and exclusive use of the space;
- A 20% commission shall be paid to the "Washington Park Foundation Inc." for ALL Art Works sold during the exhibition period and for 30 days thereafter.
