

BYLAWS

1. Our Members are called the Crusaders of this Movement. Her role is to abide by WWMG Bylaws of respecting the Sisterhood and carrying out the message of the MOVEMENT. You are here to influence each other with respect, dignity and grace while enhancing riding abilities, life skills and personal growth.
2. We encourage all Crusaders to plan rides and/or events. All rides must include WWMG in the title and the WWMG Logo in the Publications. All Crusaders must collaborate with their LCL's before creating and posting, if no existing LCL, you must consult with the Media Correspondent for Support. A checklist to create and post your event and/or ride will be provided under the files tab on the Crusader's Page.
3. Our ALLIES are another asset to this Movement. Their role is to assist and support Leadership through promotion. Our Allies can be found on our website. Please become familiar with the website so your knowledge is up to date. Please notify the Administrative Team if you will be utilizing our Allies.
4. Non-Members are NOT permitted on the Crusaders Page. Please refer them to our Support Pages as well as paying it forward by promoting membership to the movement through the website. Womenofworth.bike
5. All members are required to have a motorcycle endorsement and/or permit with a date to obtain the endorsement. She must also have up to date registration and insurance on her motorcycle, be a woman over the age of 18, must be willing to represent WWMG by wearing our Signature Patch and carrying out the Movement of Empowering Women to Ride Motorcycles. If a Crusader does not have a permit or endorsement prior to a WWMG ride, this Crusader will NOT be permitted to ride a motorcycle however, she can participate by caging it.
6. At NO time is any member or non-member permitted to market or utilize for personal use the WWMG brand including the full name of WWMG, any WWMG merchandise which includes name, logos and patches. There is a line of WWMG Supporter merchandise available. ALL merchandise including WWMG, full name or logo must be approved and/or purchased through WWMG website store at womenofworth.bike
7. Leadership can and will provide a standard ad for WWMG promotions to all Crusaders to post on social media, at any local motorcycle dealerships/shops, or events. Please ask our Media Correspondent for those resources. All promotional literature must be approved by the Leadership Team including flyers, business cards, tri-folds or any other form of publications.
8. If you are interested in any open Leadership position available in your area, you may refer to the Apprentice Tab on womenofworth.bike for information on how to begin and proceed with that process. Once that process has begun, the Administration Team will keep you connected via FB Messenger

10. At no time are we to share our closed events or WWMG business on any social media venues including but not limited to the Wind Sister Support Page or WWMG Publication Page unless approved by Administration. This information is meant for our elite Patch Holders known as the Crusaders!!

Regarding Patch Placement: We encourage you to Be Your Own Kind Of Beautiful however, out of respect to the motorcycle community, there is to be NO 3-piece patch configuration or any form of claiming your state on the back of your cuts. Please consult with your LCL, Ambassador or the Administration Team for guidelines.
