Community Leagues Rules and Code of Conduct

LEAGUE TYPES

Our community leagues run the following league types:

Redraft paid leagues \$20, \$30 or \$40

Dynasty paid leagues \$20, \$30 or \$40

PLATFORM

The fantasy ashes platform of choice is sleeper. Sleeper is currently one of the most popular fantasy football platforms out there and has an excellent interface updated regularly with excellent support by the team. Sleeper functions:

- Mock and live draft platforms
- Integrated group chat
- You can sign up for and draft in as many leagues as you like
- Live game day play by play and lightning quick scoring updates
- Animated Mascots for when you want your opponent to know about that week winning play
- The best trading platform with multi-team trades and trading of draft picks and FAAB dollars.
- IOS, Android and Laptop based platforms so you can keep up with your team wherever

CORE LEAGUE SETTINGS AND ROSTER SETUP

Core league settings: All leagues are 12 man, half PPR scoring with \$100 free agent acquisition budget and \$0 bidding enabled. FAAB budget resets to \$100 every season for dynasty leagues. 6 point TD for RB's and receiving players and 4 point TD for quarterbacks.

Roster settings for all leagues are as follows:

1 QB, 2RB, 2WR, 1TE, 2flex, 1 superflex, 6 bench spots for redraft leagues, 12 bench spots and a 5 man taxi squad for dynasty leagues.

Dynasty leagues also have 2 IR spots for injured players.

Roster settings are consistent among all leagues and have been designed to keep players active with waiver pickups and trading. They are also designed to best reflect the real value placed on offensive positions in the NFL. It is the responsibility of the participant to ensure they understand the roster and

scoring settings before signing up and drafting. Roster positions and scoring settings will not be changed

Playoff places: all leagues have a 6 team playoff format with single matchup knockout format and a week 16 championship game. The top 2 teams will receive a bye in the first week of the playoffs with 3rd playing 6th and 4th playing 5th etc.

Trade deadline: Redraft league trade deadline is 1 week prior to playoffs with waivers remaining open to allow for injury replacement.

Dynasty leagues trade deadline is 1 week prior to playoffs and trading with reopen on conclusion of the championship game. Waivers will remain open all year round in dynasty to encourage participants to remain active given the year round focus of the format.

Trade deadlines are set to maintain the integrity of the league throughout the playoffs and will not be changed.

Trade veto's: There will be no trade vetos unless there is deemed to be evidence of collusion between 2 parties to disadvantage another person or manipulate the outcome of the season. If we feel there is strong evidence of collusion the trade will be reversed with assets traded being returned to both parties involved. As collusion is forbidden under the code of conduct we reserve the right to remove the colluding parties from the league.

League Fees and Exiting leagues: League fees are payable to the fantasy ashes PayPal account and will on joining the league. Once fees are paid no refunds will be issued if you exit the league early. The buy in will be used to cover a player who picks up your orphan team free of charge for that season so as not to disrupt the league for other players. For dynasty leagues their will be an option to exit the league on the conclusion of each season. If you have traded rookie draft picks for the following year it is expected that you will cover the buy in for every year you have traded rookie picks. There will be no exceptions. If you are removed from a league because you break the fantasy ashes code of conduct then you will forfeit a refund of any league fees paid.

Prize Pool: The prize pool for each league is determined by the buy in amount not the league format. The prizes are as follows:

\$20: 1st place: \$150, 2nd place \$50, 3rd place \$20

\$30: 1st place: \$240, 2nd place \$60, 3rd place \$30

\$40: 1st place: \$370, 2nd place \$70, 3rd place \$40

Payouts: As all payouts will be processed manually by ourselves they will occur up to 2weeks on the conclusion of the season.

CODE OF CONDUCT AND DISCLAIMER

The Fantasy Ashes team have a vision to bring people together by expanding the Australian love of NFL and bringing people and communities together through fantasy football. We want to create a culture where people can have fun, learn the sport of fantasy football, meet new friends and enjoy the competitive aspects of a friendly and respectful rivalry without feeling, stressed, harassed or threatened. We are fantasy football players ourselves and we realise that it is a game of opinions and there will be friendly discussion and debate around squad building strategies and player trade valuations. We have created a code of conduct to ensure our community leagues remain a fun place for all and beginners can learn the sport. The key rules are as follows:

- Language should be kept PG rated in group chat and respectful towards fellow players and their opinions.
- Any sexist, racist or xenophobic comments will not be tolerated.
- League discussion can exist entirely in the sleeper chat and direct messaging linked to the league and there should be no pressure on any league member to sign up for a social media or chat group outside of the sleeper chat
- Collusion or acting in an unfair manner to manipulate the outcome of the league will not be tolerated
- Players are expected to remain active and must field an active team each week
