## MY COFFEE GROUNDS PROJECT

"We believe that small actions, like repurposing coffee grounds, can lead to substantial positive impacts on our environment and community."



The project will kick off with a series of educational workshops, starting with business owners , followed by schools and community members.

These workshops aim to educate participants about the composting process, its benefits and how they can get involved.

## My Coffee Cart - Coffee Grounds Composting Project

The objective of this project is to create a sustainable and environmentally-friendly initiative that repurposes used coffee grounds from our coffee carts and other participating cafes into valuable compost, benefiting the local neighbourhood house garden projects, local community thereby promoting a circular economy.

My Coffee Cart Operators, Cafe Owners, Neighbourhood Houses.

### Key Components of the Project

- **Collection:** Designated bins will be placed at each My Coffee Cart location and cafe's to collect used coffee grounds.
- **Composting:** The collected grounds will be transported to a central composting site managed by the Neighbourhood House Network, where they will undergo an aerobic composting process.
- **Education:** Informational workshops will be conducted for local business owners, schools, and community members to raise awareness about composting and sustainability.
- **Distribution:** The finished compost will be distributed to local community gardens and residents, supporting local agriculture and green spaces.
- **Community:** We are seeking to involve local community as follows:
  - Eco friendly collecting - through eco-friendly transport or logistics from cafe's to neighbourhood houses
  - Composting volunteers at Neighbourhood houses, regular volunteers catch up and discuss sustainability practices as well as attending to the composts.



Together, we can make a significant impact on our environment and build a stronger, more sustainable community.
