## How long we keep information

We will hold your personal data for as long as necessary to provide our services. Our retention period for unused or historical purchase data is 3 years, meaning if it determined there has been 3 years of inactivity then all data records will be deleted from our website and payment systems.

Historical data gathered from conference or activity attendance, membership, or email enquires (e.g., name, email address, emails, job role/institution, dietary requirements) will be held indefinitely on the ground of legitimate interest unless a request is made for these to be erased.

If you wish for you data to be erased or amends, or to make a subject access request, please contact us and we will aim to action this within 1 month and keep you updated on the request.

## Sharing information outside the UK

Where necessary, we may transfer personal information outside of the UK (e.g. cloud storage, overseas members or customers). When doing so, we comply with the UK GDPR, making sure appropriate safeguards are in place. Please contact us for more information.

## Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal data.

**Your right to rectification** - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal data you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

**Your right to erasure** - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal data in certain circumstances.

**Your right to restriction of processing** - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

**Your right to data portability** - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal data you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

Your right to withdraw consent – When we use consent as our lawful basis you have the right to withdraw your consent.

You don't usually need to pay a fee to exercise your rights. If you make a request, we have one calendar month to respond to you.
