THE FEAST OF TISHRI

Tishri is the seventh month of the ecclesiastical year in the Jewish Calendar; the first month of the civil calendar and falls during the months of September or October on the Gregorian Calendar.

The Feast of Tishri in Freemasonry derives from the Israelite Festival of Sukkoth that lasted seven days and marked the end of the harvest and was a time for thanksgiving.

The dedication of Solomon's Temple was held in connection with the Feast of Tishri and is an integral part of our Fourteenth Degree. The symbolic details in the Temple's position, design, construction, furnishings and decorations carry special meanings as they apply to the metaphorical temple of Freemasonry built in the heart of every Brother. Through these symbols we learn to recommit to building Freemasonry in the hearts of men.
