

CEREMONY OF REMEMBRANCE AND RENEWAL

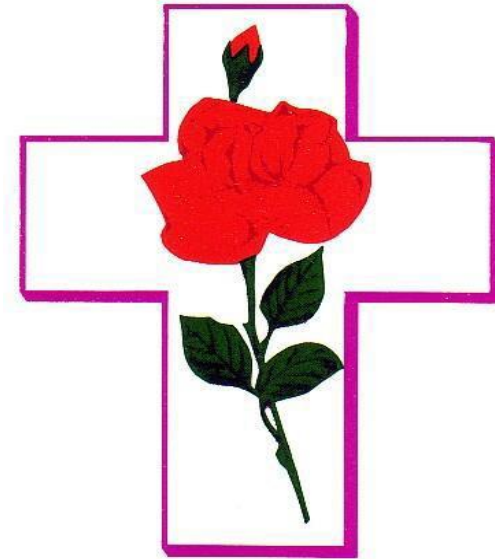
SAVANNAH CHAPTER KNIGHTS ROSE CROIX

Thus, we celebrate the lives of our departed Brethren and promise to abide by the New Law, the Law of Love, with our present Brethren and all mankind.

Prior to 1994 the Scottish Rite observed the Maundy Thursday and Easter Sunday Ceremonies. However, in 1994 it was deemed appropriate that a Scottish Rite nonobligatory "Celebration of Remembrance and Renewal" should replace the traditional and obligatory services and be held near the vernal equinox of March 21. The Ceremony of Remembrance and Renewal, including the Mystic Banquet, is not a religious observance. It is neither the Feast of the Passover nor a Sacrament of Holy Communion, although it commemorates the spirit of both days. An interesting and beautiful program has been arranged for your enjoyment. All members are urged to lay aside all other matters and meet with the Brethren on this occasion. All sojourning Knights Rose Croix are cordially invited, as are all Master Masons and their families.
