Both new Knights made their First Degree conducted by North Olmsted Council 4731's First Degree team on December 13th. In addition, two men from the new St. Mary of the Falls Council #14416 in Olmsted Falls were conferred their first degrees in the First Degree Ceremonial by our team. The Knights of Columbus continues to grow and prosper thanks to the recruiting efforts of those members who have asked Catholic men to join the K. of C.

The holiday membership drive continues thru January under this month's theme, "Bring in a Happy New Knight in the Happy New Year of 2008." Now that Christmas festivities are past, January becomes a K. of C. month of opportunities during which <u>you</u> can and should recruit new members.

4th (PATRIO<u>TIC) DEGREE EXEMPLIFICATION</u>

Attention all 3rd Degree and soon-to-be 3rd Degree members who have entered the Knights by 1st Degree prior to October, 2007.

- 1. Mark your calendar for the Dates of Friday April 4th (Hospitality Night) and Saturday April 5th (Exemplification) at the Cleveland Diocese/North Eastern Ohio Annual 4th Degree Ceremonial which will be held at the Akron Radisson.
- 2. You need to be buying your tuxedo as the basic 4th Degree uniform, assembling the tuxedo accessories: One Button Tuxedo Jacket; white pleated tuxedo shirt with lay-down collar; cummerbund, black bow tie, black studs and cufflinks, etc.

In January and February, most tuxedo retailers have clearance sales. For a first tux, Value City and K & G Men's Wearhouse offer economical tux and accessory buys, including % off coupons. For those interested in better quality tuxes, the K. of C. has package deals available.

3. You should be talking to Bishop O'Reilly Assembly #816 Faithful Navigator Ralph Kearnes -- 440-748-3627--to express your interest in becoming a 4th degree Knight.

Ralph will cheerfully tell you the duties of the Patriotic Degree:

- 1. Provide an honor guard to escort the bishops when they visit parishes for Confirmations, liturgies, building dedications, parish anniversaries, etc.
- 2. March in parish processions especially in nationality neighborhoods and for parish celebrations on feasts and saint's name days.
 - 3. Participate in parades and festivals in full regalia as the most visible arm of the Knights of Columbus.
 - 4. Engage in the Assembly's program of patriotic activities in honor of God, Flag and Country.
- 5. Serve as honor guards at the wakes of deceased 4th degree Knights, including the Farewell Sir Knight Ceremonial and the Chalice Fund.

Ralph will answer your questions on the costs of procuring the Sword and the full regalia and provide you with a Form 4, the 4^{th} degree Membership Application.


Family Activities


