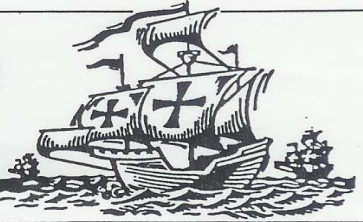

Dear Brother Knights and Friends:

The North Olmsted Council No. 4731 Knights of Columbus has been involved in a year-long project to help a group of Priests with rehabilitating their home to accommodate four or five priest. The Apostles of Jesus is an Order started by Bishop Sixtus Mazzoldi, MCCJ and Rev John Marengoni, MCCJ in Moroto, Uganda, EAST Africa on August 22, 1968. The mission of the Order is to Continue Christ Holistic Ministry so that all may have Life and have it in Fullness (JN.10.10) Thus Build together a new Civilization of Love, Justice, Peace and Life. We have come to know the wonderful Priests and have seen the work that they have done. Their mission here has been to minister to the different hospitals in the greater Cleveland area as Chaplains. They work tirelessly and independently of the Cleveland Diocese, while having no source of funds except for the few dollars earned as Chaplains and sent their way by their Order. They have been struggling with an old shuttered church rectory located in south Central Cleveland.

Our Council came to know the Apostles of Jesus when one of our Brothers went to the hospital for a problem. Our Brother Knight met one of the Priests and was touched by their compassion. All the priest have joined the Knights of Columbus and are going to make their 4th Degree this Spring. In the conversations that followed, We learned about the dire situation and poor housing of the Priests. Our *Council* Brothers, who are handy with their hands, began to arrive at the house and fix little things that desperately needed fixing. We began to see that they were *NOT* being supported by the Diocese and that the house was in need of great repair. We began renovating the house in order to provide a safe home for them to live in. Our Brother Knights tore down walls and put in doors, changed plumbing, Added two new bathroom, painted and installed a new water heaters. *We were able to fund all those repairs and changes to the house, because many items were generously donated by different stores and organizations. We donated the man hours and were happy to help our Priests.*

As winter approached, we found that the roof was leaking and had to be replaced. *Our* Council found a company that was able to help the Priests. They *were* able to fix and replace the roof including areas that needed new wood.

Now the rest of the story.

The Knights of Columbus North Olmsted Council No. 4731 needs your help. The Priests needed to secure a \$10,000 loan from the diocese, to replace the roof. The roof repair was just too steep and too high for our Council men to tackle. We are trying to defray the cost that the Priests need to pay and this is where our Brother Knights and friends can be of assistance. If you can *help us with a* donation to *assist* the Priests in staying warm and dry and *aid them* in paying off the loan the Apostles of Jesus had to incur, it would be an answer to many prayers.
