The original church was located in slavic village at 2813 East 92nd Street on Cleveland's east side. The congregation of Hungarian (Magyar) and Slovak parishioners gathered in Saint Ladislas Roman Catholic Church and it was built on August 2, 1889, There was a fire on August 8, 1970 that permanently destroyed the church. The Church of Saint Clarence relocated to its current location 2345 Bassett Road. The church now used by the parish was originally built in 1974. It was then remodeled and rededicated in 2004.


