On the May 2<sup>nd</sup> business meeting the Chavez Brothers informed and delighted the North Olmsted Council #4731. Brother Rudy Chavez informed his Brother Knights what the "Cinco de Mayo" holiday really means to the Mexican people.

Cinco de Mayo means Fifth of May in Spanish. This day is normally confused with the Mexican Independence Day of September 16<sup>th</sup>. Cinco de Mayo is the anniversary of a battle that took place between Mexican peasants and indigenous Indians against the French in 1862.

This day marks the victory of a small, poorly armed force of Mexican numbering 4,500 soldiers over the French invasion of a well trained and equipped professional French army lead by Napoleon III that numbered 8,000 soldiers. This battle is known as the legendary Battle of Puebla. The battle lasted 4 hours and ended in the victory of the small Mexican army under the direction of Gen. Ignacio Zaragoza.


This was the turning point in Mexican National Pride. They claimed victory over a very large French troop. They turned back and routed an incredible threat not only to Mexico but it is believed the Mexican aided the U.S. Government. Had the French been able to get a foothold in the Mexican Country they would have helped and supported the South against the North in the Civil War.

After the telling of the meaning and significance of Cinco de Mayo, Rudy valiantly lead the charge to the dining table and encouraged his Brother Knights to help themselves to a smorgasbord of Mexican food prepared by Rudy and his brother Edward Chavez. The Knights tasted Tacos filled with beef and topped with tomatoes, onions, cheese, lettuce and sour crème (Mexico's National Colors Red, White and Green) finished off with the Chavez Family Salsa both hot (for the inspired) and mild (for the timid souls) flavors. Rudy teased the taste buds by offering a jalapeno pinto bean and spicy chorizo sausage dip with nacho corn chips. Edward counterbalanced the chorizo with Frijoles a la Charra, a country bean dish, made with pinto beans, ham, bacon, onion, jalapenos and tomatoes made into a thick hearty soup. The Brothers Chavez also made traditional Mexican Rice which complimented the different flavors in a night that the North Olmsted Council will not soon forget. We look forward to celebrating again next year and remember "¡Viva Mexico!" and "¡Viva Los Caballeros De Colon!"
