Special note to all North Olmsted, Ohio Council 4731 members,

Our North Olmsted, Ohio Council 4731's initiation fee of \$15.00 has remained static for decades. Due to increasing costs for materials and documentation, the Financial Secretary has proposed changing the By-laws to state that the initiation fee is \$20.00. The proposed change was voted on and passed at the meeting on December 4th, 2013. Since then it has been read at 3 subsequent meeting. We are now publishing the change on our council 4731 website for further review by all the members. The by-law for Article I, Sec. 2 shall read as follows:

Article I

Section 2.

The initiation fee shall be \$20.00 except that for applicants under 26 years of age it shall be \$15.00 and for Priests and religious it shall be nil. One-half of the initiation fee shall accompany the application but it shall be refunded if the application is rejected.

### March 5-April 13 - A-Cross America Relay for Pro-Life

The National LIFE Runners Team is planning the second annual A-Cross America Relay for Pro-Life, to be run during Lent 2014. On Ash Wednesday, March 5, the East coast arm (1,997 miles) launches from the Brooklyn Bridge in New York City, and the West coast arm (2,092 miles) launches from the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco. The route passes through CA, CO, DC, IA, IL, IN, MD, MO, NE, NJ, NV, NY, OH, PA, SD, UT, WV, WY, and near KY, ID, and MN. After 40 days and 1,103 legs (~5K each) covering 4,089 miles, the East coast and West coast arms will unite at St. Joseph Cathedral in Sioux Falls, S.D., on Palm Sunday, April 13. The mission of the LIFE Runners is to pray, fund-raise, and run/walk as a team — All in Christ for Pro-Life. 0 Five ways your council can support the LIFE Runners' A-Cross America Relay for Pro-Life:0 1. The two co-founders of the LIFE Runners are long-time Knights, and all seven of the male LIFE Runners board members are Knights. Bishop Paprocki, a member of Holy Family Council 4179 in Lake Springfield and the national chaplain for LIFE Runners, said the connection between the two groups is no coincidence: "I believe it's by God's providence. In our diocese, the Knights are very active and have three main areas that they support pro-life, vocations and campus ministry. [LIFE Runners] fits in very well with those, especially pro-life.


