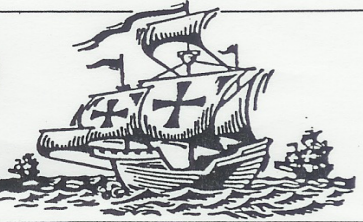

Over two thousand years ago, a small group of people captured the attention and intrigued the imagination of the entire world. At first these people were thought to be of no consequence, the followers of a man most considered to be nothing more than a preacher. But then this man was put to death. A dozen of his followers became the twelve apostles. They rose up and began telling people about his life and teachings. They began telling the story about Jesus Christ. They were not the educated elite of their time. They had no political or social status. They were not wealthy. They had no worldly authority. Yet from the very beginning people were joining this quiet revolutionary group a few at a time.

The Knights of Columbus are like the first Christians that intrigued the people of their time. The Knights of Columbus are ordinary people who embrace the Christian life today. In the great majority of cases the Knights of Columbus do not do anything spectacular. For the most part they commit themselves to doing simple things spectacularly well and with great love, and that intrigues people.

SEVERAL EXAMPLES: (1) Go out of your way to help those in need, people will be intrigued. (2) When we do what is right even if it comes at a great cost to ourselves, people are intrigued. (3) Respect and cherish your spouse, family, friends, co-workers and people will be intrigued. (4) If we live and love the way the Gospel invites us to, we will intrigue people. (5) Work hard and pay attention to the details of your work, and you will intrigue people. (6) Courage, forgiveness, generosity, gratitude, humility, kindness, patience, and thoughtfulness are all intriguing..

The Knights of Columbus can be the foundation of our community life, our family life, our intellectual life, our professional life, and our spiritual life. The Knights of Columbus establishes an integrated life, a life of integrity. The Knights of Columbus unity of life speaks more powerfully than any words ever could. A handful of men we call knights in one place and at one time giving their whole selves to seeking, discovering, embracing, and living this life, is changing the whole course of human history.
