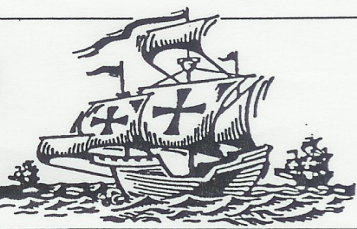

Say you are talking to someone after Mass and you want to invite him to join the Knights of Columbus.

What you should not ask:

Do you want to join the Knights of Columbus?

When you ask "do you want to join?" you are asking a closed question, and if they say "no" the conversation is closed, instead, by asking the following three questions, you will invite someone to consider joining through a more engaging process that helps open the discussion to membership, and encourages a candidate to really consider joining.

Ask these three Questions:

Are you a member of the Knights of Columbus?

Most likely no, of course we know that.

What do you know about the Knights of Columbus?

Let him speak and agree with everything, unless it is a negative.

Then tell them that the knights has made you a ,

- 1) Better Father
- 2) Better Husband
- 3) Better Catholic –It is another way of practicing my faith!!

Have you ever considered joining?

If they say "yes" they have considered joining, that is great news.

If they say "no" they have not considered joining then perhaps now they are open to that consideration.

It does not matter if they say yes or no, now is a great time to get the phone number and say that someone will contact you in the near future to tell you more about what it means to be a Knight of Columbus.

Likely the reason you joined is because someone had the courtesy to invite you to join, why not have that same courtesy?

I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection

which is quite beyond us.

He may throw me among strangers,
He may make me feel desolate,
make my spirits sink, hide the future from me—
still He knows what He is about...
Let me be Thy blind instrument. I ask not to see—
