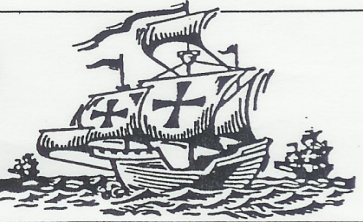

He also told about Mary & Jesus appearing on the hospital room wall in three places that stayed there for one week and the staff, patients and many from the village saw them. Ralph had pictures of the accident and the apparition, a painting of Mary as She appeared in Medjugorje and a statue of Mary Immaculate Queen of the Universe that showed on the Hospital Wall.
