Mathieson visited North Olmsted Council 4731 Brother Knight Roland "Robert" Fletcher who is 95 years old and a World War II Veteran. His wife Marie Fletcher was also with him. Roland "Robert" Fletcher joined the Knights of Columbus on April 27, 1958. He has transferred into North Olmsted Council 4731 from Council #6476 on March 1, 2000.

Roland "Robert" Fletcher shared a few of his life experiences with all of us during our visitation. He appeared very excited, bright, and cheerful when Steve and Paul came to visit. I felt something very special spiritually deeper after just being with Bob for a few minutes. Bob had heard God's word so well all through his whole life on earth that the words he chose, the phrases he used, the knowledge and insights he gained, the circumstances and situations he described, could easily be connected to the Bibles chapters and verse. Hearing God's word coming through Bob's experience in life in this manner and presentation made me feel like Bob's tongue of fire message on his experiences in life was coming from Jesus Christ himself.

I felt like his life's experience was matching the attitudes, beliefs, and behaviors of Jesus Christ. Jesus Christs teachings are implicit, unsaid rules, shared by a group of apostles, that guide their interactions with others that they come in contact with. This tendency to conform occurs in small groups and/or society as a whole, and may result from subtle unconscious influences, or direct and overt social pressure that can influence those they come in contact with. What a great living experience of "Divine Intervention" when one can hear the word of GOD and observe it in everyday life. That is an experience in life that can be cherished forever.






