3 SAINTS WILL BE CANONIZED ON DECEMBER 8 FEAST

VATICAN CITY — (NC) At least three saints will be canonized in St. Peter Basilica December 8, feast of the Immaculate Conception.

Vatican observers said there is a possibility that one or more others may be added before the joint ceremony is held.

The three are Blessed Peter Julian Eymard, Blessed Francesco Maria and Blessed Antonio Pucci.

The three were born within a 15-year period and within about 250 miles of one another.

Blessed Francesco, a Capuchin Brother, was born at Camporosso, northern Italy in 1804 and died in 1866. He was beatified in 1929.

Blessed Peter Eymard, founder of the Priests of the Blessed Sacrament, was born near Grenoble, France in 1811 and died in 1868. He was beatified in 1925.

Blessed Antonio Pucci was born near Pistoia, Italy in 1819. He became a priest of the Servite Order—the Servants of Mary — and died in 1892. His beatification took place in 1952.
