Our meeting on February 16th will be concerned with the current Anti-Smut Campaign being carried out by the Knights of Columbus. This will be an open meeting with no business being conducted. All Brother Knights, their ladies, teenage children, and friends are invited. Those in attendance who are members of this Council will be given free cigarette lighters.

We will be privileged to have as our special guest speaker, Mr. Bernard J. Stuplinski, Chief Assistant United States Attorney for the Northern District of Ohio. Mr. Stuplinski is a graduate of Western Reserve University Law School. Between 1952 and 1957 he was engaged in a private law practice. In 1957, he was appointed to the Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office, Criminal Division. While with the County Prosecutor's Office he participated in a number of cases, ranging from instances in which the death penalty was involved to constitutional questions. Mr. Stuplinski was the trial prosecutor in the much publicized prosecution of the movie "The Lovers."

In 1961 he was appointed to his current position with the U.S. Department of Justice. In addition to his government position, he has lectured before various university seminars and law schools.

Mr. Stuplinski is a member of the Southeast Council, Knights of Columbus, and is a Fourth Degree Knight in Cleveland.

This topic at our meeting will be "Obscene Literature and the Law." This will be a unique opportunity for the members of North Olmsted Council to gain a concise and accurate picture of a problem that is becoming more serious each month. As a Knight and a Christian it is your duty to support this program.

The Council Scholarship Committee held its first meeting of the week of February 4th to review the rules for qualifications prior to the awarding of four high school scholarships as provided for in the 1965-66 budget. Five members of our Council have been appointed to this committee by Grand Knight Ted Mack. Under the direction of our Chaplain, Father Wagner, they will determine which students will receive the scholarship grants.

In addition to the high school scholarship grants, applications for college scholarship grants have been received from the Ohio State Council, Youth Foundation. These applications have been turned over to the local high school principal, who will make them available to any June, 1966 graduate, who is planning on a teaching career. The scholarship is awarded with the proviso that the recipient agree to teach for at least two years in a Parochial School System after obtaining a teacher's certificate.
