QUARTERLY COMMUNION

Our Catholic Activity Chairman, John Dodd, has announced that our next Quarterly Communion will be on Saturday, March 30, at 8:00 A.M. Mass at St. Richard Church.

Following Mass, there will be a coffee and donut Breakfast in the Church Hall.

You will kindly note that March 30th is a SATURDAY. This is a radical departure from our usual Sunday Communion. The reasons for this change at this particular time are twofold:

On June 29, 1967, Pope Paul declared 1968 to be a Year of Faith. In keeping with this theme, the Ohio State Council has assigned to each subordinate Council a Day of Faith to be observed by each Council within the Lenten Season. The date assigned to North Olmsted is March 30th.

Secondly, since we have an obligation for a Quarterly Communion, Bro. Dodd has wisely combined the Day of Faith to coincide with our Communion. An additional fringe benefit might be a larger turnout of Brothers for our Communion. So many of our Brother Knights are involved every Sunday as CCD instructors, ushers, Lecturers, etc., that many of them are physically unable to join with us in our Quarterly Communion.

Therefore, no valid excuse can be offered for not attending on this Saturday morning.

Please mark your calendar accordingly, and we'll see you at Mass, Communion, and the Breakfast!!!
