IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER LEADWOOD PWS Failure to Meet Nitrates Monitoring Requirements for Drinking Water

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During January 01, 2025 to December 31, 2025, we did not monitor or test as required and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?
