- The pier is .5 miles from the ship to the tram stop, we found the walk took us 12-15 minutes at a regular pace.
- The distance to the tram does make it inconvenient to go back to the ship, so be aware when packing and planning.
- The pier is smooth concrete, guests who have a hard time carrying their beach items may want to consider bringing a small rolling suitcase or rolling beach bag.
- Golf carts can be arranged with guest services in advance for guests with disabilities.
- There are a limited number of strollers and wagons just outside of the ship to help with the walk with littles.
- Towels are available once ON the island after exiting the tram, so no need to get them outside the ship like on Castaway Cay. We loved this difference.
- The trams run consistently from Mabrika Cove (A) near the pier to Goombay Cultural Center (B)
- The tram ride took 8-10 minutes one-way.
- From getting off the ship to getting to the beach at Lookout Cay, it took us 30 minutes.



- The beach is GORGEOUS baby powder sand and turquoise water perfect for the 'gram.
- Only the beach highlighted in [orange] is beach-front where you can see the ocean easily with lounges, seats and umbrellas. The [purple] area are high dunes with walkways over them. There are lounges/seats/umbrellas in the [pink] area, but the view of the ocean is minimal or none at all while seated.
- My favorite area is marked with checkboxes, near the water park, food, bar and bathrooms.
- Exiting the tram we grabbed towels and walked to the right, looking for the water park tower and using that as our guide to find the beach spot we wanted.
- Beach-front spots are limited, so I do recommend exiting the ship as soon as you can to secure one.

• The beach-front area isn't physically separated from the family area, so head to the left of the beach for a

quieter experience.









• The beach-front area (9) at Serenity Bay looks exactly like the rest of the family beach area. Goregous teal ocean and baby-powder sand!




- There are several wood bridges that get hot, so sandals are a must on the island.
- We saw a wild stingray, so as with all beach locations, I recommend water shoes and shuffling your feet to alert them to your presence
- There are some small reefs in the water that you can rent snorkeling gear for, or bring your own.
- Unlike Castaway, there are no float rentals.
- There are life jackets available for kids and adults for free.
- Next we will explore True-True BBQ and True-True Too BBQ

- The island did have flies that made dining more difficult, I suggest a fan to help with flies hopefully Disney will find solutions for subsequent sailings.
- The busiest time to eat is noon when lines were long, we ate at 1pm and had no lines for food.
- True-True BBQ has 5 pavilions and True-True Too BBQ has 4 pavilions.
- There are different food options at each window, so you may need to visit multiple windows/lines to get everything you want.



- Next, we will focus on the middle part of the island, where most of the action is.
- We noticed there were no hooks/benches in the bathrooms for belongings and no changing rooms you had to change in the bathrooms so be prepared for that until they (hopefully) add some hooks/benches or create some space for just changing. We will bring hooks/bag magnets of our own next time.
- (B) is the Goombay Cultural Center Tram stop, this is where you can pick up all your towels after exiting the tram.










- Finally, we will explore the kid's/tween's and teen areas on the island and the nature trail

- Play, Play Pavilion and Triton's Stage









