I am writing to urge you to take decisive action to draft and enact measures to support the creation of an international space traffic management system. As space activity continues to grow rapidly, effective international coordination, collaboration and shared binding rules are essential to ensuring safety, stability, and long-term access to outer space for all nations.

The increasing number of satellites and debris in orbit has raised the risk of collisions that could damage critical space infrastructure and threaten the national security, scientific, commercial, and humanitarian uses of space. Without a coordinated international framework for tracking, data sharing, and traffic management, these risks will continue to escalate, potentially leading to avoidable collisions and the resulting long-term (in some cases, centuries) harm to Earth's orbital shells and the space environment.

I respectfully ask that you demonstrate leadership by enacting and/or supporting laws, regulations, policies and international efforts that:

- Call for and support an international convention to: negotiate, adopt, and ratify an international space traffic management treaty before the U.N. Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space (UNCOPUOS)
- Promote international cooperation, collaboration, and data-sharing on space object tracking
- Establish clear and binding rules for responsible and compliant behavior in orbit
- Advance the development of an internationally led, transparent, global space traffic management organization

Ensuring safe and sustainable use of outer space is not only a technical necessity but also a matter of global responsibility. Proactive leadership on space traffic management would help reduce conflict, protect vital services on Earth, and preserve outer space as a shared resource for future generations.

I urge you to prioritize this issue and work with international partners to turn these goals into action. Your leadership can play a critical role in shaping a safer and more cooperative future in space.
