UAW Announces Strike on General Motors, Ford and Stellantis

Corporations have not gotten the memo that this is a workers economy. That working people will no longer accept the scraps given to them by employers. When Stellantis has a \$16.79 billion dollar profit and Ford has a \$17.93 billion dollar profit in 2022, and General Motors posted a \$22 billion dollar profit on June 30th of this year; workers know there is money to spare in salary and benefits. The crumbs will not cut it anymore.

In 2021, CEOs earned 399 times that of the typical worker. The CEO of General Motor made \$28.97 million dollars last year. Ford Motor Co. reported that their CEO made nearly \$21 million in total compensation in 2022 and the CEO of Stellantis NV received \$24.8 million in 2022, a 22% increase from 2021. Once again, there is money to spare.

Workers **make** the profits for these multinational, multibillion dollar corporations. UAW members are the ones generating the salaries these CEOs enjoy. And these workers have had enough of watching their employers get rich off their labor. CBTU stands in support of the workers, their demands and their fight against greed. All union members stand in solidarity with our striking brethren – from SAG-AFTRA and WGA to UAW. Workers of the world unite!
