If you have never applied before, create an account using an active email address and password to complete your application. Check your email for confirmation to complete Step 2.

If you are a returning applicant, use the same email address and password as previously registered. Follow prompts to complete application process.



Electronic Application Process

After submitting your application, you will receive a confirmation email. YouthWorks will verify and process the electronic application. You will then receive an email indicating your application has been approved OR if your documents are incomplete.

How to apply for a work permit if 14-17 years old and provide to YouthWorks

- 2. Fill in your information and enter the company information below

3. Review your permit and click 'View/Print Permit', Sign your work permit and have your parent/guardian sign.

4. Lastly, save the work permit and attach it to your application.
