

NEW JERSEY STATE POLICE CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATIONS COURSE

COURSE DETAILS

Background

This basic crime scene investigation course provides comprehensive instruction in crime scene investigation for a total of thirty five days of training over a seven week period. The goal is to create standardized training for crime scene investigators. The ultimate responsibility of the crime scene detective is to conduct an investigation which results in a comprehensive work product that in turn maximizes the potential for yielding the greatest amount of forensic and investigative evidence.

Course Content

The two hundred-eighty hour course will be academically accredited by Seton Hall University. Students will receive undergraduate credits for this course. Individual certificates of completion which satisfy an eighty (80) hour basic course in Fingerprint Identification, a forty (40) hour basic course in Bloodstain Pattern Analysis, and a forty (40) hour basic course in Shooting Analysis and Reconstruction will be awarded along with an overall certificate for completing the two hundred-eighty hour course in basic Crime Scene Investigation.

Key Modules of the Course

- Fingerprint Identification
- Fingerprint Identification/Palm Print Identification/Latent Print Processing/Courtroom Testimony
- Forensic Photography
- Forensic Anthropology/Clandestine Grave & Body Recovery
- Shooting Reconstruction
- Bloodstain Pattern Analysis
- Laboratory/Speakers/Medical Examiner's Office
- Simulated Crime Scene & Court Room Exercise

The Aim

To provide the student with the knowledge and skills essential to the investigation of crime scenes and familiarize the student with the many areas associated with advanced investigative techniques.

Instruction includes lectures in an academic environment coupled with practical exercises offering the student the opportunity to apply techniques in situations often encountered at crime scenes.

Entry Requirement

Must be a detective in law enforcement. Application must be approved by the course coordinator.
