Poster Guidelines & Instructions for Workshop Participation

Participation Requirements

- Selected authors must register for the Design Education Summit 2025 and indicate their participation in the workshop.
- Authors are expected to present their extended abstract proposals in poster format at the workshop.
- Self-print your poster. There is no need to submit it in advance.

1. Poster Preparation

Participants/teams are requested to prepare and bring a poster based on your abstract. Purpose: of the poster is to present your extended abstract clearly and visually to encourage discussion.

Size & Format

- Recommended: A1 – A0, portrait or landscape
- Legible fonts (24 pt+ for body text)
- Clear sections and hierarchy

Suggested Sections

- Title & Authors
- Introduction / Background – Brief context & problem
- Objectives / Research Aim
- Methods / Approach / Pedagogical Strategies
- Findings / Insights
- Impact on design education or practice
- References / Acknowledgements
(optional, keep minimal)

2. Workshop Structure (1.5 hrs)

- **Introduction & Welcome** (15 min)
Overview of workshop goals and themes
- **Poster Session** (60 min)
Participants present their posters, grouped by thematic areas. Opportunity for discussion, feedback, and idea exchange. In-person.
- **Closing & Next Steps** (15 min)

- Pins and boards will be provided on-site.
