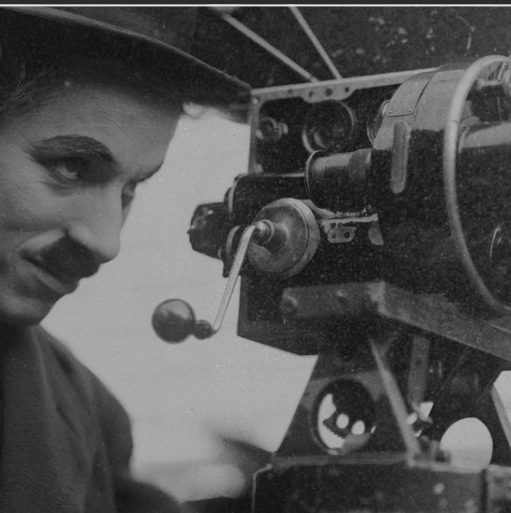

With your support, this once in a generation project will position the Auditorium as a year-round cultural hub, including one of the world's most influential arts events – the Sundance Film Festival.

A PARTNERSHIP FOR THE AGES

Winterizing the Auditorium will allow Chautauqua and other local arts organizations to host live music, film screenings, panel discussions, and other events that blend the magic of live events with the intimacy and warmth of Chautauqua's spectacular venue – all year round.

With increased availability to this year-round venue space, we can:

- Foster dialogue and connection among artists, filmmakers, and audiences in an unparalleled setting – the Chautauqua Auditorium.
- Elevate Boulder on the global arts map while boosting local economic activity.
- Provide year-round cultural programming, expanding Boulder's capacity for performing arts and cultural events.



Designers, architects, engineers, and builders are working together to create a fire resistant, structurally sound, accessible and conditioned space that will protect and preserve the historic Auditorium while allowing it to operate comfortably year-round.

The winterized design includes additional insulation, radiant heat floors powered by a new geothermal system, and removable insulated wall panels to create a warm, welcoming space for up to 1,300 filmmakers, festivalgoers, performers, and community members during Colorado's winter months.

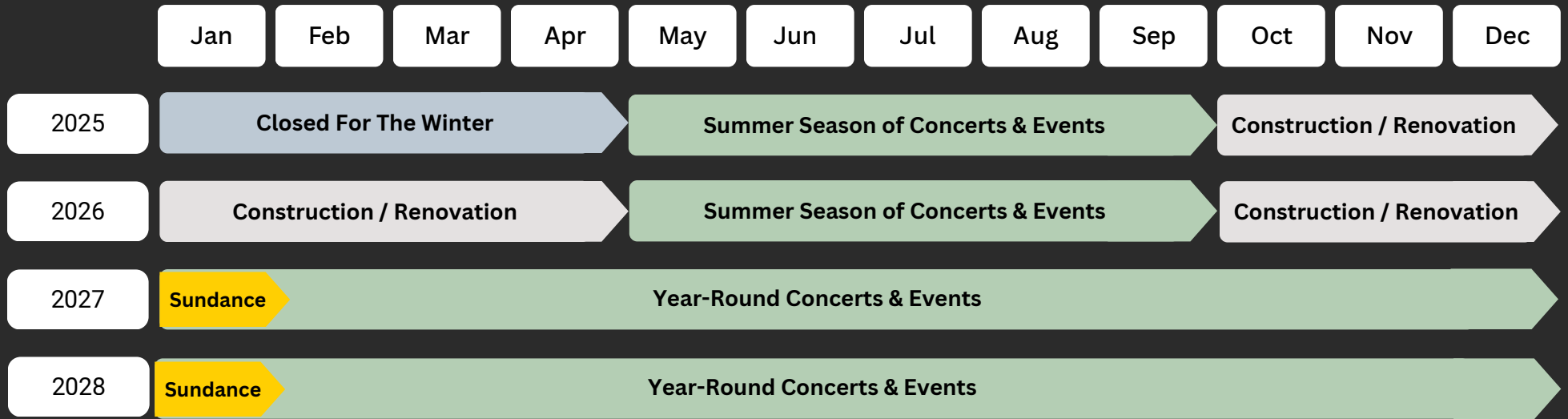
Without changing the Auditorium's historic exterior, its footprint, or its historic charm, these panels will be installed each fall and removed each spring, preserving the barn-like charm and character that have defined the summer experience at Chautauqua for generations.





THE TIMELINE

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Construction will be completed in two phases

Phase I: October 2025 - June 2026

Phase II: October 2026 - December 2026

Beginning in 2027, the Auditorium will be open year-round, adding over 200 days of community programming potential each year, including the Sundance Film Festival in January.

THE INVESTMENT

Chautauqua's \$18 million investment will preserve and protect the Chautauqua Auditorium, Boulder's crown jewel, for generations to come.

The project includes:

- State-of-the-art nitrogen-based fire suppression system
- Structural reinforcement of historic building elements, including columns and trusses
- Insulated shell
- Radiant heating system powered by geothermal energy to ensure winter comfort
- Industrial generator with both single and three phase capabilities
- Acoustic and lighting upgrades to meet the technical requirements of high-profile film screenings
- Accessibility enhancements so that all audiences can share in the experience



PARTNER WITH HISTORY

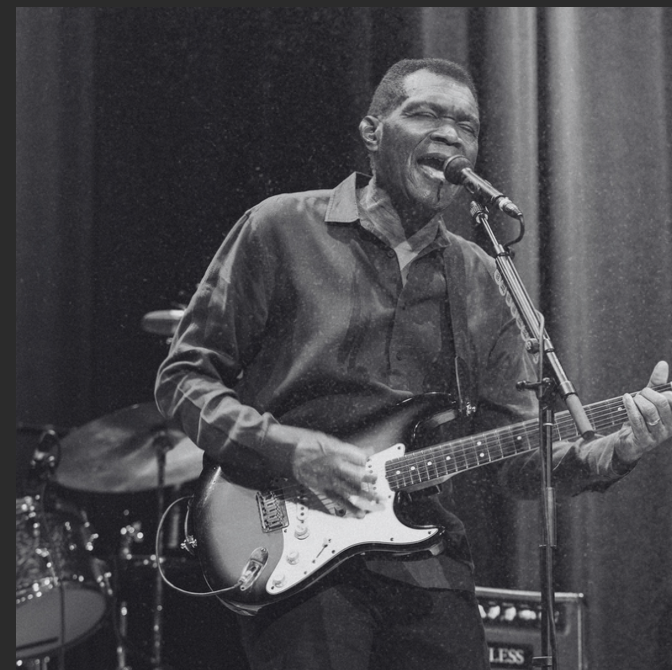
