What are my options to pay my bill?

Customers can use choose one of the following to pay their bill:

1. Quick Pay on our website
2. 24/7 interactive phone line
3. MES Power App

How do I enroll in bank draft?

Customers can enroll in bank draft on our website. We also offer debit/credit card draft and that can be set up in your MES online account.

How do I access my online account?

In order to access your online account, we need a valid email and phone number. Once you have provided those to MES, visit our website at mesystem.net and click **Pay My Bill** and then sign in. Click **Create Account** and follow the steps to create a new user. You can pay your bill, view your statements, and manage your contact information all by using this portal!

What should I do if my power goes out?

When the power goes out, chances are MES is already on it! To report a power outage please call (931) 473-3144. Our crews will work as quickly as possible to restore power back to your home/business.

When is my bill due?

Bills are due on the 17th of each month.
