3 Financial update (TM)

- TM sent apologies and sent report ahead (appended to minutes)
- To question with Tim: his report says WebCollect fees have increased due to the number of members on the system, and WebCollect currently has >300 records despite club membership being 224. Would the cost go down if we purged records of ex-members? Action: TM to advise
- Tim still to remove Alun and add TG/EG as admins to PayPal and SumUp. Action: TM

4 Training (LN)

- LN sent report ahead (appended to the minutes)
- LN has also advised of her resignation from the role of Training and Coaching coordinator.
 - Louise was thanked for all her work in the role.
 - Louise explained that in addition to the more "technical" aspects, there was more work involved in managing run leaders than she had expected.
 - Louise to try and write a role duties list. Action: LN

 - Louise confirmed that she will continue with other work as a coach, eg leading track sessions and supporting members with training plans, alongside our other coaches.

 - Louise informed us of the difficulties in getting this up-to-date, but we are now almost there with it (only John Singh outstanding, and he has promised to do it). This was largely down to the need for all run leaders to log on and accept new Ts&Cs, which naturally some forgot to do and needed chasing, but others struggled with logging on.

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- Ewan expressed his gratitude for bringing this up-to-date. EA have seven "club standards" and this was one of the two in which we weren't compliant.

5 Membership update (MF)

- Brief discussion re recent leavers. Two have left to specialise in Triathalon and join a more suitable club, one is more of a concern because it looks as though there may have been some sort of "falling out", Ewan offered to discuss further with her but she declined, so nothing more we can do.

6 Club main events

BMWR (AG)

- Good news is we were not charged for the Sportsshoes vouchers (£400) for prizes last year.
- Possibility this will be the same this year, considering officially asking Sportsshoes to sponsor the event by donating them.
- Lower costs this year due to bulk buying of race momentos last year: will only need to buy a few.
- Penistone Hill: Cricket club available with indoor space for changing, registration, toilets etc, cost £35. Changeover position will not be moved though, so no changes to route.
- Laycock Village Hall and Rugby club both sorted, same price as last year.
- Silsden: housing development was a concern. Anthea has driven up and nothing looks any different, though do need to check we still have the "waste ground" available for registration table, toilets etc. Anthea was advised that a nearby house belongs to Richard Smiths sister, she will confirm if this is still the case and make contact via Richard.
