POOLS/SCREEN ENCLOSURES

- Pools must be in-ground. Pool and all equipment cannot be visible from the street. Typically a Privacy Fence would be required for a pool and equipment.
- Pools and Enclosures must meet all Florida Building Codes pertaining to safety fencing, alarms, equipment, locks etc. Proper permitting must be done by the owner. All Covenant and County setbacks must be met.
- Enclosure color must match the house overhangs or brick/siding color.
- Any related yard grading cannot negatively affect any adjoining properties.
