We are playing a Bowmaker format.

Scoring

Bowmaker uses the Stableford scoring system, where the final team score for each hole is based on the two best scores from the team. The scoring is as follows: Handicaps are 3/4 club handicaps with a max handicap of 21 for non club members with no official handicap.

1 point for par, 2 points for a birdie, 5 points for an eagle 8 points for a Hole in one

0 points for a bogey, -3 points for a double bogey or worse (so you need to finish each hole)!!

Hole 1 PAR 5 | YDS 531 | Si.9



A tricky opening par 5: A left to right dog-leg with cleverly placed trees and out of bounds down the right hand side. Avoid the deep greenside bunker front right

<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"A challenging opening tee shot that requires accuracy to hit the left side of the fairway opening up the rest of the hole. Club selection is key for your approach shot, anything long will be a challenging up and down."

Hole 2 PAR 3 | YDS 168 | Si15



An uphill par 3 to a long narrow green. Bunkers front left and right guard the green.

<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"Take more club than you think here. A deceptive par 3 that punishes anyone who is short."

Hole 3 PAR 4 | YDS 344 | Si. 11



A short par 4, sloping gently right to left. A deep bunker front right of the green catches any ball coming up short.


<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"A well placed tee shot left of the oak tree will leave a short approach into the green. Beware, anything too long off the tee will leave you blocked out."

Hole 4 PAR 4 | YDS 423 | Si. 3



The highest point of the course, this is a dead straight hole. The fairway rolls to the right and the shortish rough down the left hand side leaves you in trouble. Another hole where a par is a victory.



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

This is a strong par 4. It requires 2 well executed shots to hit the green in regulation or a well placed 2nd shot favouring the left side of the fairway will give the best chance of making a par."

Hole 5 PAR 5 | YDS 571 | Si. 7



A downhill par 5, with a difficult tee shot from the white tees, there is a large wood on the left which runs the length of the hole. The green slopes from front to back, making the approach shot challenging.





"A downhill par 5 offers a great chance of birdie. A good drive at the marker post will set you up well, but beware of the bunkers guarding the green."

Hole 6 PAR 4 | YDS 442 | S.I 1



A long uphill par 4 to a "postage stamp" green. No margin for error. This hole is stroke index 1 for a reason

<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"You need nerves of steel to hit the left side of this fairway, offering the best chance to hit the tiered green in regulation. Don't be disappointed with a bogey on this hole."

Hole 7 PAR 4 | YDS 346 | S.I 17



A short downhill par 4, with a right to left dog-leg. Should be a straight forward hole but you need to avoid the 3 strategically placed bunkers on the left hand side of the fairway



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"A simple hole for anyone who places a good tee shot to the right of the bunkers leaving a short approach into the green."

Hole 8 PAR 4 | YDS 453 | S.I 5



A long par 4 with everything running to the left. The trees are hard to avoid, but don't think the fun ends when you get to this 2 tiered green!!

<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"A long, challenging par 4 with not much room for error. You must favour the right hand side, but difficulty lies ahead if you go long of the green."

Hole 9 PAR 3 | YDS 165 | S.I 13



A very difficult par 3 normally into the prevailing wind. This hole has a very narrow approach and is surrounded by bunkers.



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"Accuracy is key when hitting into the smallest green on the course. Good luck avoiding the bunkers."



Hole 10 PAR 4 | YDS 364 | S.I 6



A tricky dog-leg par 4, with the tee shot being key. The large green may look interesting, but the severe back to front slope make it the most difficult 2 putt on the course.



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"The tiger line from the tee is over the mound. All approach shots must be left below the hole, long of the pin is not an option."

Hole 11 PAR 3 | YDS 154 | S.I 12



A picturesque par 3 to a sloping green with bunkers surrounding it. Little room for error on the left hand side and of course everything funnels towards the trouble.



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"Left is dead! Any shot into the heart of the green will set you up for a great birdie chance."

Hole 12 PAR 4 | YDS 340 | S.J.10



A short par 4 over a valley, with stunning views of Bath and Kelston. Driveable to the longer hitter, but easy to end up in trouble with a large greenside bunker front right and a pot bunker front left.



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"You can open your shoulders on this one. Be careful of the downslope before the green to avoid any unkind bounces."

Hole 13 PAR 4 | YDS 423 | S.I 2



Long par 4 to a three tier McKenzie green. Everything slopes to the right to a tight fairway, with some well placed trees to catch the wayward shot.



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"The line is just left of the marker post from the tee. Hitting the correct tier of the green is essential to avoid a putting nightmare."

Hole 14 PAR 5 | YDS 476 | S.I 16



A straight forward par 5, with out of bounds right and trees down the left. The longer hitter can get on in two, but bunkers short of the green stop the running shot.

<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"A difficult tee shot to avoid the out of bounds on the right, but a good chance for the longer hitters to reach the green in 2. A challenging approach shot to negotiate with the severe slope in front of the green."

Hole 15 PAR 4 | YDS 298 | S.I 18



The shortest par 4 on the course, downhill to a sloping green. Panoramic views across Bath can be enjoyed from the tee. Plenty of danger beyond the pin.





<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"A tee shot favouring the left side of the fairway is key as the hole slopes away to the right. Longer hitters can reach the green, but mayhem can be caused if you are too close or long."

Hole 16 PAR 4 | YDS 385 | S.I.4



Re-crossing the valley, a deceptively long par 4 with bunkers guarding the second shots. Trouble looms on the right hand side.

<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"Left of the marker post is the line to avoid the valley leaving a tough 2nd shot into the postage stamp of a green, but if your going to miss, left is best."

Hole 17 PAR 3 | YDS 156 | S.J.14



The signature hole. A drop hole par 3, with a lake fed by a stream and a deep bunker protecting the green, guarded from every angle.



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"Left of the marker post is the line to avoid the valley leaving a tough 2nd shot into the postage stamp of a green, but if your going to miss, left is best."

Hole 18 PAR 4 | YDS 363 | S.I 8



A very tight drive, through an avenue of trees, out of bounds threatens you on the right and dense woodland on the left. Everything runs left to right.

<u>Hole Sponsored By</u>



<u>Pro's Tip</u>

"You can breathe a sigh of relief after a good drive here allowing the ball to kick down from the slope. Anything on the fairway leaves a simple approach into the green to finish the round." Scorecard
