

APPLE SPRINGS ROAD DISTRICT
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2012-06-R

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT TRANSPORTATION OF MATERIAL,
WHICH MAY BE HARMFUL TO THE ROAD

WHEREAS, it shall be unlawful for any association, corporation, firm, partnership, or person to transport any material, including water, waste material, glass, rock, dirt, water, construction material or other articles, by its weight or volume which may be harmful, settling, erosion, chipping, cracking, or other damages to Apple Springs Road District road system right-of-way, and;

1. Any speed limits, vehicle weight limits, and any other vehicle or traffic regulations on District roads may be enforced by any law enforcement officer.
2. In the event of any damage occurring to the road or right-of-way, the Apple Springs Road District Board of Trustees will send a notice by certified or registered mail to the person, firm, or corporation causing such damage. The permittee will have thirty (30) days upon receipt of the notification to correct the deficiencies or the District shall cause to have the work done. If the District must cause to have the work done, the association, corporation, firm, partnership, or person shall be responsible for any costs and expenses associated with said repair.
3. In addition to any other penalty authorized by State law or County Ordinance, each violation of this ordinance subjects the individual to a fine of five-hundred (\$500.00).
4. If any fines, costs and expenses are not paid to the Road District Treasurer within 30 days of notification of violation, the sum along with any late charges and/or penalties will be extended in a lien against the landowner of the described property or violator of this provision.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Apple Springs Road District Board of Trustees adopt the foregoing ordinance. Dated this 19th day of July 2012.
