

APPLE SPRINGS ROAD DISTRICT
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2012-02-R

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE OVERNIGHT PARKING ON THE
ROAD SYSTEM OR RIGHT-OF-WAYS

WHEREAS, the Apple Springs Road District Board of Trustees deems it necessary, for the purpose of promoting safety and general welfare of the District to adopt an Ordinance so no person shall park vehicles of any type, recreational vehicle (RV) or trailer overnight on any District Roadway or Right-of-Way, and;


1. Any speed limits, vehicle weight limits, and any other vehicle or traffic regulations on District roads may be enforced by any law enforcement officer.
2. All violations of the provisions of this Ordinance and shall be convicted thereof, shall be punished by fine of not more than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars.
3. The party or parties involved shall be responsible for the removal of the vehicle or trailer. If Apple Springs Road District is required to remove the vehicle or trailer, expenses of these protective operations will be billed to the individual responsible.
4. If these costs and expenses are not paid to the Road District Treasurer by the 30th of the following month of occurrence, the sum along with any late charges and/or penalties will be extended in a lien against the landowner of the described property or violator of this provision.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Apple Springs Road District Board of Trustees adopt the foregoing ordinance. Dated this 21st day of June 2012.
