Eligible Trustee Nominee Criteria

34A-5-21.2 Residency of district trustees.

To serve as a trustee of a sanitary district with **less than one hundred residents**, a person shall be a resident of the sanitary district or a United States citizen who owns real property within the boundaries of the sanitary district.

34A-5-28. Trustees and employees not to be interested in District transactions.

No trustee or employee of a sanitary district may be directly or indirectly interested in any contract, work, or business of the district, or the sale of any article, the expense, price, or cost of which is paid by the district, nor in the purchase of any real, personal, or other property belonging to the district, or which shall be sold for taxes or assessments, or by virtue of legal process at the suit of the district.

Eligible Voter/Nominator Criteria must meet at least one of the following:

1. Be a registered landowners in the Apple Springs Water Works Sanitary District with South Dakota drivers license.
2. To serve as an eligible voter/nominator of a sanitary district with **less than one hundred residents**, a person can be a United States citizen who owns real property within the boundaries of the sanitary district.
3. Non landowners living in the Apple Springs Water Works Sanitary District with a current SD state voter registration card / South Dakota ID. This refers to adult children or other relatives (aunt, uncle, parent, etc. who live with the landowner.
4. Any firm, partnership, LLC, association, estate or corporation owning property in the district has only one vote and may designate an officer or agent to vote on its behalf.
