

APPLE SPRINGS ROAD DISTRICT  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2012-04-R

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE SIGNAGE

WHEREAS, the Apple Springs Road District Board of Trustees deems it necessary, for the purpose of promoting safety and general welfare of the District to adopt an Ordinance so no person shall place a sign of any type on any District Roadway or Right-of-Way, and;

WHEREAS, that it shall be permissible to place temporary sign for the purpose of home or property and/or yard sale shall not be within eight (8) feet from the edge of curb or roadway, shall be unlit, limited to one (1) sign per parcel, limited to a maximum size of 28" x 28" and is to be maintained in good condition and;

WHEREAS, that it shall be permissible to place temporary administration and directional signs required during development to advice of caution or warn of danger, and such signs as may be required by law, and;

WHEREAS, to offset the costs of repositioning or removal of signs not properly maintained, all violations of the provisions of this ordinance and shall be convicted thereof, shall be punished by fine of not more than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per sign, and;


WHEREAS, if this fee is not paid to the Road District Treasurer within 30 days of notification of violation, the sum along with any late charges and/or penalties will be extended in a lien against the owner of the sign or landowner of the described property or violator of this provision, and;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Apple Springs Road District Board of Trustees adopt the foregoing ordinance. Dated this 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 2012.
