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How to Stay Spiritually Free After Deliverance

After being set free from the enemy we must be intentional to remain free by keeping the doors closed and filling "the house" with the nature of God, and by filling ourselves with the Holy Spirit. Our bodies are the temple of the Holy Spirit and "the house" in which God was meant to dwell in.

"When an evil spirit leaves a person, it goes into the desert, seeking rest but finding none. Then it says, 'I will return to the person I came from.' So, it returns and finds its former home empty, swept and in order. Then the spirit finds seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they all enter the person and live there. And so, the person is worse off than before. That will be the experience of this evil generation." ~ Matthew 12:43-45 ~

What exactly does this all mean? We need to make sure when we have been spiritually healed and delivered from demonic bondage and oppression that we fill ourselves, our "houses", with the truth and teachings of God and that we fill the empty spaces left by unclean spirits with the Holy Spirit so they do not have a place to return to. After being set free, it's very important that we continue to pursue the things of the Lord and not go back to the same lifestyle of sin as before that allowed demons to have legal rights to access us and to torment us.

So, what should we do? We need to continue to feed our spirits with godly truth, continue to lead a pure and holy lifestyle, walk in humility, and righteous living. Develop a personal relationship with God, seek to be more like Jesus daily, develop a strong and meaningful prayer life and be in the Word of God daily by reading the Bible. We need to repent of our sins quickly and sincerely if we falter and we need to forgive others freely. Our goal should be to grow stronger spiritually and to grow closer to our Heavenly Father and our Lord and Savior, Yeshua every day. We must strive to pursue only Christ-like things in our lives and turn from the wicked and sinful ways of the world. As disciples of Jesus Christ, we must remember that we are in the world, but not of this world and we must live accordingly, living a life that is righteous and that is pleasing to God. We do not want to live a life that welcomes sin and reopens demonic doors that could give any demon legal right to oppress us again after we have spiritually set free and released from the enemy's lies and manipulations. If you find that you have sinned against God again in any way, it is very important that you repent to Him very quickly and stop intentionally sinning, including any ungodly behavior. God loves us and has sent His Son, Yeshua, to pay for our sin debts; that is how much He truly loves His children in this world. The enemy will want to put doubt and condemnation in your mind if you backslide after deliverance. Satan is the master of lies, do not listen to him. GO back to the Father, repent of your sins quickly, close every open door to the enemy and continue to seek the face and truth of Jesus Christ in all that you do.

The Mind: The main battlefield of the enemy's attacks is often in the mind, therefore in order to stay in our spiritual freedom we must renew our minds daily through prayer and staying consistent in the Word of God. We must take every thought captive. Stand firmly and courageously in the authority that Jesus Christ has given you through the gift and the blessing of the Holy Spirit.

This is truly the way to worship Him. Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Be filled with praise and worship for God and be filled with His holy presence.

As we submit to God, and as we strive daily to seek Yeshua's face and to be more like Him, we can effectively and actively resist the devil and walk in the FREEDOM THAT JESUS CHRIST HAS GIVEN TO US.
