

BATHROOM CLEANING CHECKLIST



Bathroom Cleaning Supplies

- Toilet brush and bowl cleaner
- Spray bottle with tub & tile cleaner

Clean rags or paper towel

- Microfber cloth to polish and shine
- Vacuum

Rubber gloves

- Stif brush
- Steam or microfber mop

Remove

- Bath mats or rugs
- □ Anything on countertops
- Dirty laundry
- □ Wastebasket (and empty it!)

Spray

Apply your preferred cleaning product to areas that need to be cleaned. Let it soak in while you clean other areas.

- □ Sinks
- 🔲 Bathtub
- □ Shower
- Toilet

Wipe

Use a rag or sponge to work from ceiling to foor, wiping down all surfaces in the bathroom (except the mirror and toilet).

- Light fxtures
- □ Vent fans
- Curtain rods
- ☐ Shower fxtures
- □ Sink faucets
- □ Vanity & countertops

Scrub

Return to areas that you previously sprayed and use a sponge or a stif brush to remove soap scum and mildew. Rinse with clean water or rinse your sponge in the sink as you scrub.

- Shower walls
- 🗖 Bathtub
- Shower door glass
- Toilet

Floor

□ Vacuum the foor and bathmats. Use a steam mop or microfber mop with disinfectant to fnish.

Shine

It's the details that make a diference. Finish up with a dry rag; buf and shine everything!

- Faucets & fxtures
- Drain caps
- □ Handles & knobs
- ☐ Mirror

TIP: Keep bathrooms cleaner longer by keeping disinfectant wipes below the sink. Use disinfectant wipes to wipe down surfaces between cleanings.
