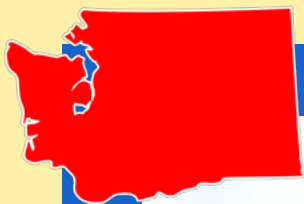
WELCOME TO NAVAL STATION EVERETT

built.



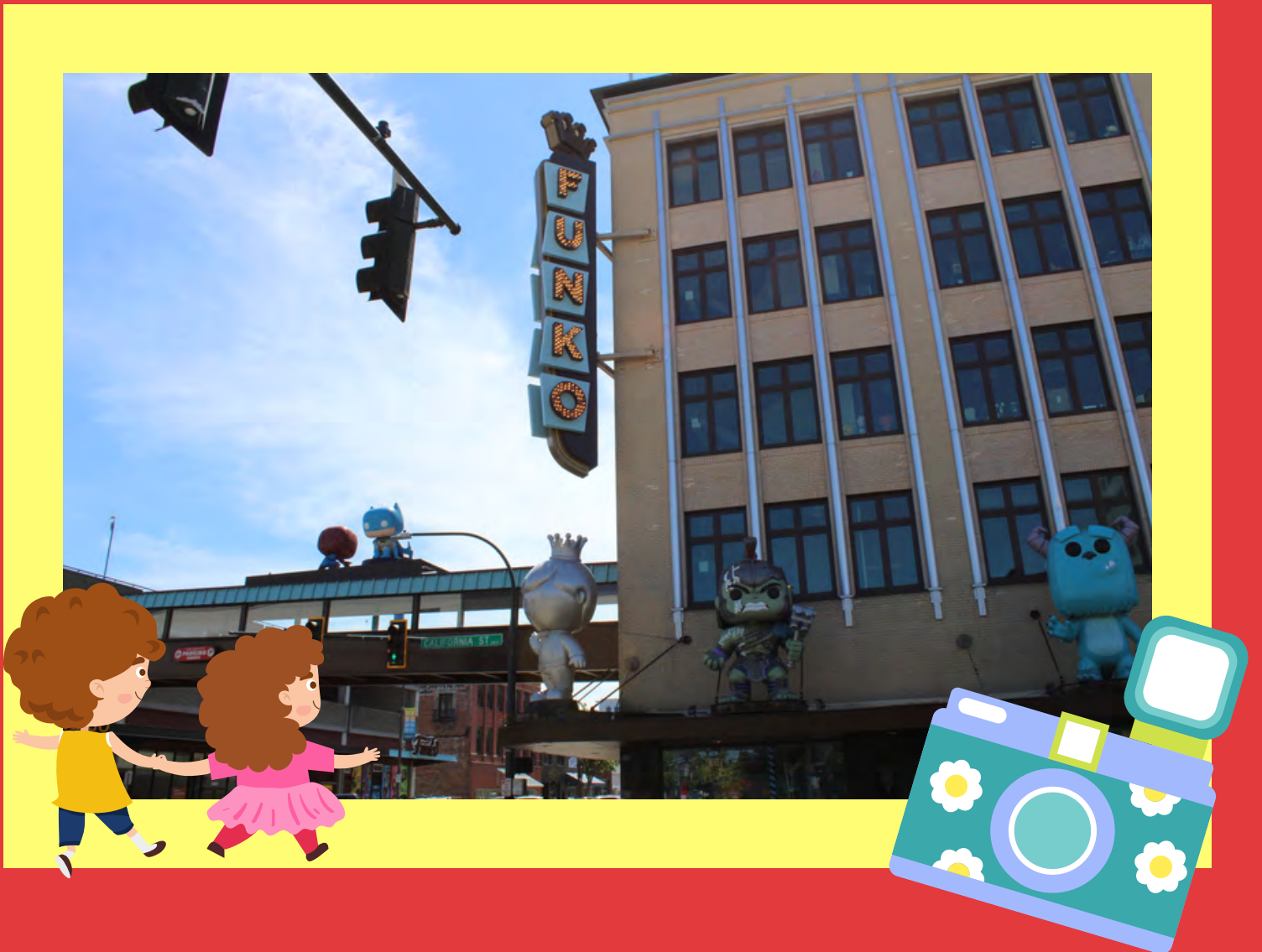


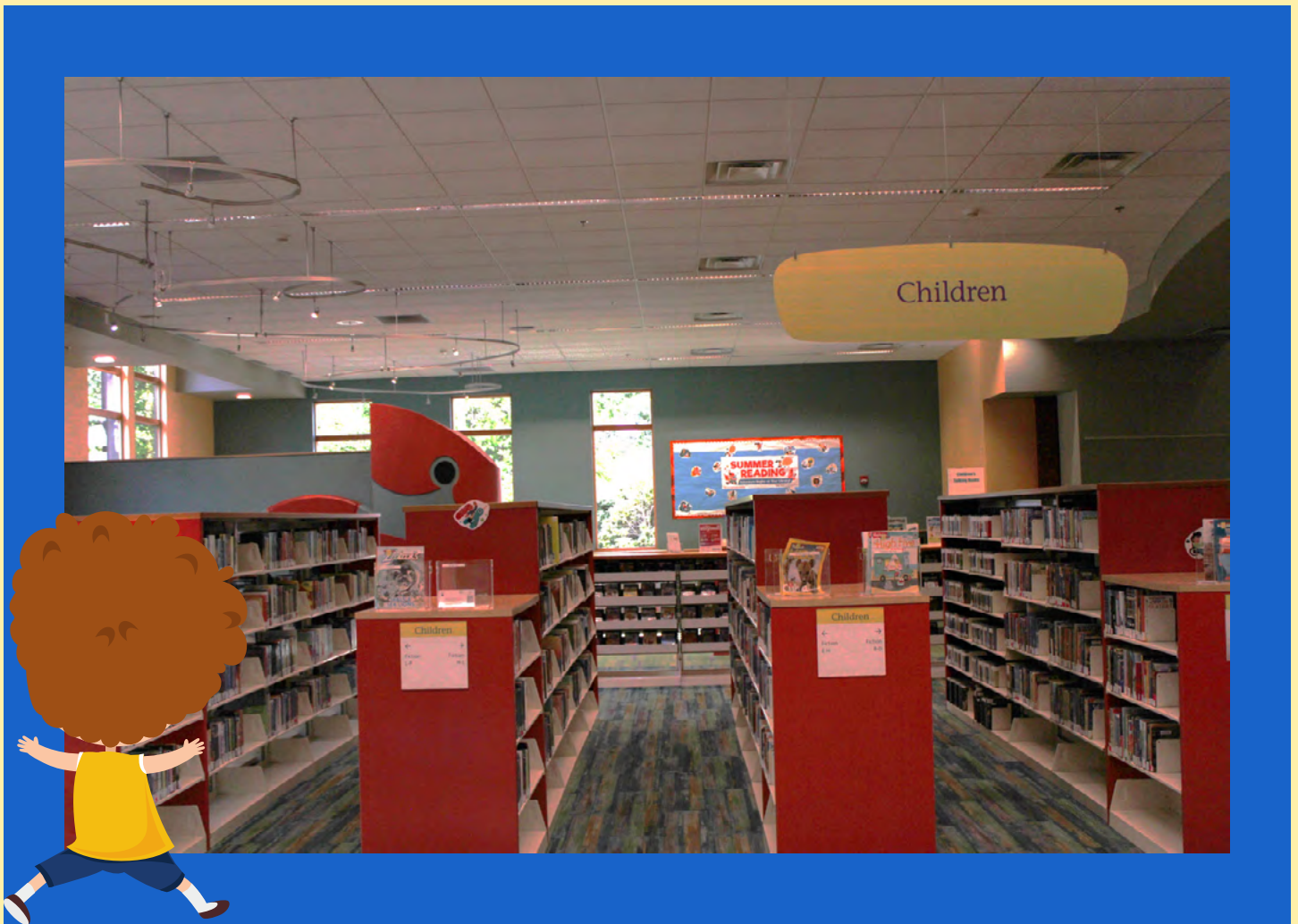
Here is the Everett
