Cecilia Rinn embodies the passion and joy of belly dance, sharing its magic through captivating performances and inspired instruction. With ethereal grace and fluid movement, she transforms dance into a transcendent art form, enchanting audiences at a variety of celebrations and events. As a sought-after instructor, she teaches and performs both locally in **Boise**, **Idaho**, and nationally, mentoring the next generation of dancers.

A dynamic producer and choreographer, Cecilia is the creative force behind **The Big Bad-Ass Belly Dance Show**, a theatrical belly dance production that will celebrate its **15th anniversary** at Boise's **Visual Arts Collective in February 2025**. She has also produced **The Art of Belly Dance Show** for over a decade, featuring legendary artists such as **Delilah and House of Tarab (2016)**, **Karim Nagi (2017)**, **Myra Krein (2018)**, **Beth Quist (2025)**, **and Elasanne Barrows (2025)**. She is the founder of the **StarBelly Dancers**, an elite dance company, and a dedicated mentor to four rising professional belly dancers at the **StarBelly School of Dance**.

Cecilia's dedication to community arts extends beyond the stage. She directed the SEEDs program for at-risk teenage girls in 2013 and 2014 and has plans to revive it in 2025. Her talent has taken her across the world as a featured performer in the internationally touring production Invaders of the Heart, with "The Radiant Tarot" in 2023 and "The Return" in 2025. A recognized leader in her field, Cecilia has received multiple grants, including support from the Idaho Commission on the Arts (2017) to attend the P.U.R.E. Conference in New York and from the Boise City Department of History and Art (2019) for the "Arabic Folkloric Dance Celebration". Most recently, she directed "Raks of Ages" at J.U.M.P. in June 2023 and is producing Boise Raks Events in 2025.

Beyond dance, Cecilia is an accomplished artist and storyteller. She holds a **Bachelor of Science** in Social Science from Boise State University and is an award-winning filmmaker and graphic artist through her production company, Full Tilt Boogie L.L.C. Her documentary, *Belly: Sensual, Scarred, Scared*, premiered at the **2008 Idaho International Film Festival** and has since toured nationally. It is currently available on Amazon.

Her artistry also extends to fashion and design. As a **professional seamstress and costume designer**, she creates stunning belly dance costumes for herself, her students, and commissioned clients. She is also the creative force behind **StarBelly Creations**, where she handcrafts exquisite tie-dyed silks and clothing, celebrating the beauty of movement and self-expression.

A lifelong student of folkloric traditions, modern raqs sharki (belly dance), and fusion styles, she is passionate about bridging societal and cultural divides through dance. Tori sees movement as a powerful tool for education and inspiration, encouraging people to celebrate differences, embrace cultural heritage, and, most importantly, get up and dance.
