CPTED School Campus Maintenance Checklist

Natural Surveillance	
•	 □ Trim trees so lower branches are above 6 feet and shrubs are below 2 feet to maintain clear sightlines. □ Keep lighting around walkways, entrances, and parking lots working properly. □ Remove or relocate obstructions that block views of doors, windows, or play areas. □ Replace burned-out light bulbs immediately and clean light fixtures regularly. □ Ensure security cameras and signage remain visible and unobstructed.
Natural Access Control	
•	 □ Confirm gates and fences are intact, secure, and properly locked after hours. □ Repair or replace broken locks, door hardware, or latches promptly. □ Make sure pathways and signage guide visitors to main entry points clearly. □ Inspect perimeter fencing and access points regularly for damage or wear.
Territorial Reinforcement	
•	 □ Keep school signs, murals, and landscaping well maintained to show care and ownership. □ Remove graffiti or vandalism immediately to discourage repeat offenses. □ Ensure boundaries are clearly defined with maintained landscaping and walkways. □ Report damaged or missing school property such as benches, signs, or planters.
Maintenance & Safety	
•	 ☐ Maintain good housekeeping around the property—remove litter and debris daily. ☐ Inspect and repair broken windows, lighting, and fencing promptly. ☐ Check that emergency access routes are open and clearly marked. ☐ Document and report recurring problem areas or maintenance concerns.
