

CHSAA Proposal — 23 games

One area that has been demanding much of our time this off season is the new proposal for increased contests that will be sponsored and proposed at the January Legislative Council. The Board has decided to take the issue really in to our own hands as we have been meeting with AD groups statewide and lobbying for this important initiative. It really is quite simple. We are asking for an additional 4 contests. This would be 23 games max. And would allow parity with Volleyball and

Basketball. And, I'm happy to say, it is gaining momentum and popularity. The survey that you coaches responded to from last February where you overwhelmingly (86%) favored more contests, is evident. This proposal is as simple as it gets and **if all of us simply have that conversation with our AD asking for support**, this will pass January 25th.


