

2020 Rochester's Top Workplaces: Complete list of winners

Top Workplace

Sixty-six companies made the cut to win a place on the 2020 Rochester's Top Workplaces list.

The list below is alphabetical, by size category. The ranked list was scheduled to be announced at a special awards ceremony and dinner in March, but that event was postponed due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The rankings will be announced at a newly scheduled ceremony and dinner, with the date yet to be determined.

So, who determines Top Workplaces? The best judges: the employees who work there.

For the seventh year, the Democrat and Chronicle partnered with Philadelphia-based Energage to rank the Rochester area's Top Workplaces. The process is based on a scientific survey of employees who rate their workplace culture. It also gives company some insights into what makes them unique.

Any organization in the region was eligible to participate, provided it had at least 35 employees in the region. Employers could be public, private, nonprofit or governmental. There is no cost to enter the Top Workplaces program.

For 2020, a record 100 employers agreed to take the survey. Combined, they employ 16,288 people in metro Rochester. Of those employees who received questionnaires, 10,002 responded, either on paper or online.
