Lesson 2 Looking for God's Footprints

Part One — Follow the Trail

Look back over your life and write about moments where you see evidence that God was leading you.

Reflect on these questions:

- When has God protected you?
- When has God answered a prayer?
- When has something worked out that should not have worked out?
- When did God provide something you needed?
- When did He open or close a door?
- When did He comfort you during a painful season?
- When did something happen that felt beyond coincidence?

Part Two — Your Evidence List

Create a list called:

"Evidence That God Has Been With Me"

Write at least 7 moments, big or small.

Examples:

- A prayer He answered
- Protection from something you did not see at the time
- Unexpected provision
- A person He sent into your life
- Strength during a difficult season
- Peace during chaos
- A situation that changed suddenly

Part Three — Reflection

Write a short paragraph answering:

"If God was faithful then, what does that tell me about where I am now?"
