



ALASKA: DENALI ADVENTURE TOUR

Day 1:

Arrive into Anchorage Airport and meet your local guide. Transfer to your local hotel.

Day 2:

Today travel by motorcoach north to Denali National Park. Along the way, visit the Iditarod Headquarters and learn more about the Last Great Race. Next, visit a sled dog kennel and meet a local dog musher. Board your motorcoach and travel north to Denali Area.

Day 3:

Today is your opportunity to explore Denali National Park. Board your Tundra Wilderness Tour into the 6.2-million-acre park. Keep your eyes out for wildlife: moose, grizzlies, caribou, wolves, and Dall sheep.

Day 4:

Tour the Denali Visitor Center. Motorcoach to the mountain climbing community of Talkeetna. Meet at the Ranger Station to learn about climbing Mt. Denali (North America's tallest peak) and experience a Virtual Climb. Enjoy a guided hike around a local lake. This evening, board your deluxe dome railcar to Anchorage.

Day 5:

This morning, head south to the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center for a look at the wildlife of the north. Then travel by motorcoach to Prince William Sound for a glacier cruise (3 ¾ hours).



Day 6:

Today, tour Alaska's largest city, Anchorage. Enjoy a visit to the world-class Anchorage Museum. At the Imaginarium Discovery Center, discover science of particular interest in Alaska. You can touch a sea star, create an earthquake, shoot an air cannon, experiment with gravity and much more. Visit the Alaska Native Heritage Center where you learn about Alaskan Native culture through dance, tool making, storytelling, and explore six authentic life-sized Native dwellings situated in a wooded area around beautiful Lake Tiulana.

Day 7:

Transfer to the Anchorage Airport and depart for home.
