GCLSL Tips and Resources

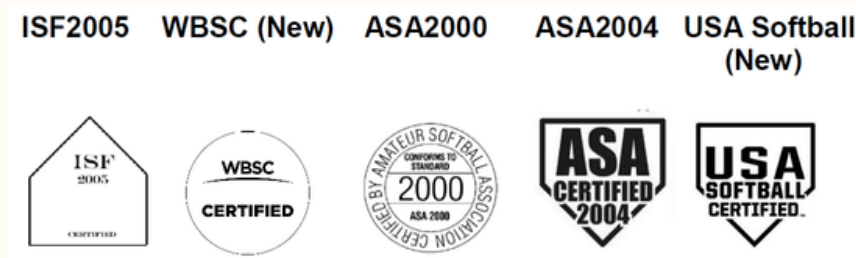
As the GCLSL is a fastpitch league, all bats must comply with Softball Canada regulations.

In accordance with Softball Canada rules, the following bats are approved for league play: Any bat listed on the WBSC Softball Approved Bat List with a valid ISF 2005 certification stamp or WBSC certification (as shown below).

Any bat listed on the USA Softball Approved Bat List with an ASA 2000 or 2004 certification stamp, or the USA Softball 2019 certification stamp (as shown below).

FAST PITCH - MALE (UP TO U20) AND FEMALE (ALL LEVELS)

Acceptable Certification Stamps:



Additionally, the bat must meet the compression standards set by the certifying organization and may be tested to ensure it falls within the acceptable range. The bat must also pass a visual inspection according to the Softball Canada rulebook.
